

Oregon Field Guide

Three dams on the Klamath River were breached earlier this year, and the reservoirs above them have been drained. The empty Copco Lake bed is now an expansive mud flat with a river running through it, and **crews with the Yurok Tribe are planting native seeds in the mud by hand to help restore the landscape**. Deconstruction work will begin next month at JC Boyle, Copco 1 and Iron Gate dams in the country's largest dam removal project.
