

Growing up in the Yurok and Karuk Tribes, Brook Thompson learned to care for the fish that nurtured her and her family. She knew that along the Klamath River in Northern California, salmon and lampreys are a needed part of life. But she also saw how these fish were in danger. People had built dams along the Klamath River, making it very hard for salmon and lampreys to live. Tribal people and their friends organized to have four of the dams removed, and they won. In *I Love Salmon and Lampreys*, Thompson tells this inspiring tale, and she shares how it motivated her to become a scientist. Featuring a dyslexia-friendly font and adorable illustrations by Anastasia Khmelevska, as well as fun facts about salmon and lampreys, this is a stirring story about stewarding nature for the generations to come.

Brook M. Thompson is a part of the Yurok and Karuk Tribes. She is a neurodivergent and Two-Spirit author with dyslexia. She has a BS in civil engineering from Portland State University and an MS in environmental engineering from Stanford University, and she will soon have a PhD



This core, extracted using advanced equipment, contains air bubbles and particles that reveal past temperatures, greenhouse gas levels, and volcanic activity across multiple ice ages. Studied in harsh icy regions like Antarctica or Greenland, it helps researchers understand ancient climate patterns and predict future changes, offering critical insights into how the planet responds to global warming.

Kiara Nirghin, a young innovator from South Africa, created a biodegradable superabsorbent polymer at just 16 to combat drought. Using agricultural waste like orange peels and avocado skins, rich in polysaccharides and pectin, she developed a material that can absorb up to 300 times its weight in water. This eco-friendly innovation helps retain moisture in dry soil, improving crop growth in water-scarce regions.

Her groundbreaking work won the Google Science Fair Community Impact Award, highlighting how sustainable solutions can revolutionize agriculture, water conservation, and global food security.

"California is no stranger to drought. The worry about water usage is an ongoing concern for homeowners and businesses alike, but at the Waldorf Astoria in Beverly Hills, the lush landscaping suggests they don't have a water worry at all. "We can really plant a full tropical landscape or really whatever we want to do because we don't have to worry that we are wasting water and taking water away from others," said David Alagem, VP of technology and sustainability at Alagem Capital Group. The reason for that peace of mind can be found in the basement of the hotel. The Waldorf recently converted its water recapturing system to Epic Cleantec, which allows them to treat and reuse all of the hotel's shower and ink water to irrigate the landscaping throughout the property. ... 




